Appearance and Maintenance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paintwork condition • Graffiti • Rubbish disposal • Cleanliness • Smells • Signage • Other 	7	General environment around station quite pleasant. Long walk to platform. On West side. On West side: pedestrian/cycle lane from Rowley Terrace. Possibly the best old style shelters seen so far but in need of a hand of paint. Quite clean. No smells. Few graffiti, most were cleaned (some faintly visible). New style rubbish disposal (square bins). Station sign, timetables and electronic display on both platforms. (Photo 9)

(Photo 10) No close neighbours; but shops and park close by, no hidden areas and there are visible security cameras. Pedestrian gates. Lighting is fairly good on both approaches and both platforms.
Car and Bike Parking <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No of Spaces per Mode • Asphalt or gravel? • Bike chain-up secure? 	7	Car parking near station (asphalt) and also empty dirt block on West side used for parking. (Photo 7) 5 Bike lockers on East side; next to pedestrian approach ramp.
Disability Access <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At Approaches • Ramps to platform • On platform 	5	Access at approaches and ramps to platforms interrupted by flat section at half way (improved accessibility?). Elevated wheelchair ramps on platforms near shelter, but not under shelter.
Facilities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Toilets • Seats • Food • Shade and Rain Shelter • Loudspeakers • Ticket sale point 	6.5	No toilets. Seats under shelters, on both platforms. West side sits about 24 people. East side: about 16 people. Disabled seats. There is a kiosk building but it has been untenanted since 2007 at least. Shelter is quite good. Loudspeakers.
